To get to The Lights take I-5 to exit 212. Head approximately 5.25 miles west to Stanwood. Turn left at the 4th light onto 88th Ave NW and go .25 miles to stop sign. Turn right onto Marine Drive and travel south for 4 miles to the camp entrance on the right.

Park your car in Stanwood, and ride the FREE shuttle bus to the Warm Beach Lights of Christmas, a Northwest holiday tradition. The last bus will leave Stanwood at 8:00pm and the last ride back leaving Warm Beach is at 10:00pm. The trip takes approximately 15 minutes, depending on traffic.
