

## **Detective Report – April 2014**


During the month of April I have been dealing with a few cases notably an indecent exposure incident involving two victims. In an effort to identify the suspect I requested Det. Piticco complete a composite sketch of the suspect. After the sketch was completed it was shown to both victims. Both victims identified the sketch as matching the suspect. This sketch was placed on numerous social media sites along with the Stanwood Camano News Paper in an effort to identify him. DOL vehicle registration checks were completed as well to attempt to locate the vehicle involved as only a partial plate was provided. To date no suspect has been located or identified.

On Saturday April 20, 2014 I was called out from home to investigate a home invasion burglary and sexual assault. During the investigation a male suspect was identified, located and arrested for Burglary 1 degree and indecent liberties. The suspect confessed to entering into the residence of a female who awoke at night to find a male standing over her and touching her. The male was startled by the victims sister who was staying the night and ran from the scene. The suspect was later located and interviewed where after sometime confessed to being in the house and touching the victim. Suspect was booked into the Snohomish County Jail on multiple felony counts. Thanks to the efforts of several Stanwood Police Officers along with a great team effort this individual was quickly located and caught.
