
Detective Report – August 2014

The Robbery at Costal Vie Espresso which I have been working on has been solved. Thanks in part to a tip received from a person whom had seen the picture on our Face Book account. Although I only received what this person thought was the suspect's first name. I also was given a location the suspect was thought to regularly get off the bus at on Camano Island. With this information and his physicals I was able to determine who this person possibly was. A further search of Face Book and booking photos revealed what I had hoped to find, the tattooed left arm, noted by the only witness who had seen the suspect leaving the area of the robbery.


With this information and the assistance of the Island County Transit I was able to locate this individual who was riding on the Island County Transit into Stanwood on 08-18-14. The suspect was arrested and brought to the PD where Post Miranda he confessed to the Robbery.

On 08-14-14 I was assigned to a case involving a stolen truck, assault on a police officer and a domestic violence incident which all occurred on the same day. The suspect who thanks to the help of many of the Officers and Deputies involved was caught with the use of a K-9. This case is still being worked as many of the loose ends are being tied up. The individual responsible was booked on several Felonies and is still being held in the Snohomish County Jail.
