City density per square mile is 1,967 with 1,050 persons living in the designated flood plain area.



Detective Report – February 2014


The month of February has been very eventful. There have been notable increases in vehicle prowls. Bartell's had a robbery on the 12th in which the suspect got into a physical confrontation with the employee striking her in the head several times as he attempted to leave the store with a bottle of liquor. This individual is the same person who is responsible for other similar incidents. Thanks to a great team effort from everyone he was caught the following day, not too far from where he originally committed the crime. After he was arrested he confessed to the Bartell's incident along with a similar incident two weeks earlier, (OO-14-00072).

The QFC robbery is still under investigation. Suspects are believed to be two Hispanic males driving a white Toyota/Honda which was seen headed toward Camano Island. Several leads are being investigated.
