Detective Report – January 2014


I believed the commercial burglar who used a rock to gain entrance to several businesses in the city of Stanwood has been identified. I learned via a news story the suspect had been arrested in Bellingham on 01-21-13. The suspect confessed to Bellingham Pd to about 20 commercial burglaries. Arlington and Marysville went to speak with him and he confessed to additional Commercial burglaries in those jurisdictions. At some point during the interview with these two agencies the suspect who was in custody at the time decided it might be in his best interest to quit cooperating with Police. He is described as a 45 year old white male who calls himself the “Rock Star.” He bases his name from the method of entry he uses to break into businesses (Throwing a rock through the window)

I learned when Police went to speak with him one of his unusual requests was he wanted to be hired as a security consultant for the Police Department to educate community businesses on how to better protect themselves from people like him. Similar to the Movie Catch Me if You Can or the All State spokesman “Mayhem”


I actually contacted and spoke with the suspect in the Whatcom County Jail. In talking with him he immediately directed me to speak with his Attorney.

The QFC was robbed on 01-18-14 at approx. 0355hrs. Based on eyewitness accounts two Hispanic males masked and gloved entered the store demanded money, then fled on foot north bound, entered an awaiting vehicle sped away from the scene. Information is still being compiled and processed in this case.
