
Detective Report – July 2014

The month of July started out with a Robbery of the Costal Vie Espresso stand located inside of the Viking Village shopping area. The suspect fled the area via foot north bound and thanks to a witness and the K-9, it was determined he had changed clothing in the grassy area about 200 yards away from the incident. A person of interest was identified but it was later determined to have not committed the Robbery. After an extensive search using a variety of video sources in the area it was determined the suspect had entered QFC. Video images of the suspect were obtained from QFC. The photos were presented on various social media resources along with main stream media shows. This effort lead to a name which enabled me to identify the individual I feel is currently the most promising lead in this incident.


The suspect responsible for the Robbery which occurred in the Viking Village Laundry Mat has been identified and arrested. He was booked into the Snohomish County Jail by the SCSO Directed Patrol Unit without incident. He is being held on \$250,000 bail facing several Felony Charges.

The final suspect in the Port Susan Middle School burglary incident was identified and interviewed by me. He has admitted his involvement in the burglary and charges have been referred to the prosecutor.
