
## **Detective Report – May 2014**

Below are the stats for the month of May. I was able to close several cases this month including continuing to work on the Burglary case from April where a male had entered the victim's home. All video from the night of the incident was collected from the Hotel Bar. The video had to be reviewed and copied prior to being entered into evidence. My understanding in communicating with the Prosecutor on this case was the suspect pled guilty after being offered a global resolution which was mutually agreed upon by all parties involved.


A trafficking in stolen property case is ready to charge and is now closed. It involved a son stealing property from his parents to facilitate his drug addiction. It was closed primarily because the parents were not willing to pursue charges against their son once it was discovered he was the one responsible for the theft.

A DV case I was assigned for follow up originally reported by the victim's mother who lives in Mount Vernon and reported the incident to Mount Vernon PD is now closed. After consulting with the Prosecutor's Office and having an opportunity to interview the victim who offered up a different set of circumstances explaining how she received her injuries and with no direct witness to the assault, this case was closed.
