
Detective Report – November 2014

The Costal Vie Espresso Stand robbery which was resolved a few months ago and referred is finally being charged into court.


The results of the Robbery at Viking Village where the suspect assaulted the victim in the Laundry mat and then stole his vehicle resulted in guilty plea; a 60 month prison sentence was immediately imposed.

On November 25th, the Port Susan Middle School received a bomb threat. The threat was sent via an I Pod by a student using a wireless internet connection while he was waiting in the parking lot on a school bus. The suspect in this case who attends the high school was able to access the school's unsecured printer where he photographed a fellow student then placed a caption under that picture detailing the threat to the school. Due to the nature of the threat the school was cleared and thankfully no device was located. Thanks to a great team effort by many of the staff at both Port Susan Middle School and Stanwood High School the student featured in the picture was identified which resulted in identifying the person who had taken the picture. This individual was contacted and subsequently confessed to the threat and was booked into the Denny Youth Center.
