

Detective Report – October 2014


There were a few vehicle prowls in the city of Stanwood in the 9700 block of 272 Ave NW (cases 683 and 692). The first incident took place on 10-07-14 involving the theft of several credit cards which were subsequently used throughout the city of Stanwood at various businesses. Thanks to some good initial work by Deputy Chaney the suspect was identified. While searching for the suspect it was discovered he had been booked on a similar matter although not associated with Stanwood's case. Using various still shots of the video images initially collected by Deputy Chaney I was able to arrange a meeting at the jail with the suspect in the case. During our discussion and Post Miranda I was able to show these images to the suspect. It was because of the information I had the suspect confessed to the entire incident which included entering into the victims vehicle; taking the credit cards, then using them throughout the city of Stanwood.

This suspect was released from jail around the 16th of Oct. A few days later Oct 25th (case #OO-14-00733) the same victim associated with the vehicle prowls occurring on 10-07 was victimized again. She again left her cards in the car this time in the center console instead of her purse. The cards again were used in Stanwood but additionally used in the city of Everett. This time Deputy Espeland obtained video which resulted in the identification of the same suspect. I located the suspect near the AM PM and with the assistance of Deputy Pilgrim he was arrested. The suspect again confessed to entering into the vehicle of the victim and using her credit cards. He was genuinely shocked to know it was the same person he had victimized twice. Both he and the victim claim they don't know each other.
