Detective Report – September 2014


The Robbery which occurred this summer at Costal Vie Espresso has been referred to the Prosecutor's Office for consideration, on one count of Robbery 1st .

The incident which began with the theft of a Semi Truck and evolved into a relatively serious incident involving multiple agencies, victims, witnesses has been referred as well. I did the initial booking on this case referring 10 Felonies on the suspect. After additional follow up additional charges were added. The suspect is still being held in the Snohomish County Jail on \$502,500.00 bail.


The burglary where a weapon was stolen has also been resolved. This occurred sometime ago but I kept the file active as there was good suspect info in this case. I was able to locate one of the suspects in this case who had moved to Eastern WA. In a phone conversation with him he finally confessed, stating he had entered the house with another subject who ended up stealing the firearm. I will be driving to Eastern WA later this week to obtain a written confession from him. This hopefully will lead me to the recovery of the stolen weapon and the charges of Burglary 1st on these two individuals.

The individual responsible for the Robbery which occurred at the Viking Village Laundry Mat this summer involving the assault of an elderly male and the theft of his motor vehicle is slated to head to trial. This individual is still in jail; his bail is set at \$250,000.00 dollars.
