"A right-of-way access permit is required for any work within the right-of-way. Such work may include utilities work; lane closures; driveways; curbs; sidewalks; and haul routes. Permission to temporarily close a street or portion thereof for construction activities or special events is obtained through the right-of-way access permit.

Before any person, firm or corporation shall commence or permit any other person, firm or corporation to commence any work to grade; pave; level; alter; construct; repair; remove; excavate or place any pavement; sidewalk; crosswalk; curb; driveway; gutter; drain; sewer; water; conduit; tank; vault; street banner; or any other structure, utility or improvement located over, under or upon any public right-of-way or easement in the City of Stanwood, or place any structure building; barricade; material; earth; gravel; rock; debris or any other material or thing tending to obstruct; damage; disturb; occupy; or interfere with the free use thereof or any improvement situate therein, or cause a dangerous condition, a right-of-way access permit shall be obtained. A separate permit shall be obtained for each separate project.

The right-of-way permit shall include formal traffic control plan(s) per the MUTCD as applicable and include detailed restoration complying with City Standards. Road restoration shall comply with the Public Works Standard Detail T-8."

In addition, "The City's approval of this ROW permit does not constitute the City having liability. Applicant shall hold harmless and indemnify the City. **Herein set forth.**

By signing this application, the applicant agrees to comply with the conditions of the permit and the Street and Utility standards of the City of Stanwood.
